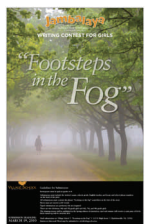


The **CENA** is coming, **Tuesday, April 27**.

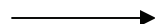

The **8th grade trip to Smith Island** is next **Monday-Wednesday, April 19-21**.

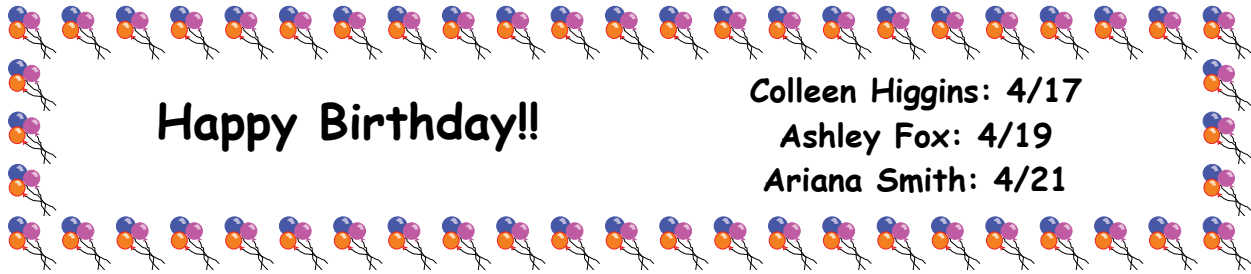
A packing list and food assignments are in today's folder.
