

ACTING

The kids will learn the basics of acting through improv games, technique exercises, imagination journeys, rehearsals and performance. They will learn how to audition in a professional environment and then be cast in their roles for the week. We will play with character building techniques, learn how to empathize and find the truth in their stories and explore the journey and purpose of their characters within the context of their scenes.

PROP ARTS

The kids will be working on "behind the scenes" art projects that will include aspects of set design, prop making, makeup and masks relating to their acting scenes and Broadway routine.

BROADWAY SINGING

The kids will also be introduced to the wonderful songs of the theatre. They will learn some musical theatre history as well as performance exercises in projection and the embodiment of the song. They will ultimately learn a fun uptempo Broadway song.
